

CHIRP Recommend System Settings

The Indiana State Immunization Registry (CHIRP) is a web based application that can run on virtually any computer that has an internet connection and web browser. For optimum CHIRP performance we recommend the following settings;

- Windows Compatible PC or Laptop using a Pentium III or better processor.
- Internet connection speed of 768kps download, this speed will handle up to 6 work stations
- Microsoft Internet Explorer 6.0 or better
- Java Plug-In 6, build 1.6.10 or higher, for Internet Explorer
- Add CHIRP as a trusted site to IE, <https://chirp.in.gov>, access should include;
 - Enable Active X Scripting
 - Enable Java Scripting
 - Disable Website Phishing
 - Disable Pop-Up Blocker
- Add <https://chirp.in.gov> as a trusted site to Virus Scanning Software, if installed
- Add <https://chirp.in.gov> as an allowed connection to Firewall Monitoring Software, if installed
- Average “Ping “ of 90ms, four packets should be sent and received with zero request time outs
- 1024 x 768 Resolution, or better
- “Normal Size” 96 DPI Display Setting
- Printer using PCL type print driver – only needed for printing Vaccine Cards

CHIRP will work on a wired or wireless network. If a wireless network is being used, it is recommended that it is a Wireless G or N connection. With a Wireless G connection, no more than 4 work stations should be connected per router. The Internet Download Speed of 768kps per 6 machines should also be considered when using a wireless connection.
